FOOT BALANCE CASE STUDY

Foot balance x rays are used to assess how the conformation of the foot and the bones within may influence a horse's movement and soundness. Alongside your farrier, we can use them to guide shoeing and improve the balance, which can improve soundness and performance.



CASE STUDY

NAME: Millie AGE: 12 years BREED: ID X TB

USED FOR: BE Eventing, SJ and Dressage

HISTORY

Millie's owner Georgie had noticed that she was not quite performing up to her usual standard. Upon completing their BE100 event, Millie was unfortunately lame on her left fore when being unloaded off the lorry.

EXAMINATION

With no obvious heat or swelling Hayden performed nerve blocks to try to localise the lameness. Millie's lameness on the left fore was localised to the foot. Once the left fore improved, Millie started to show lameness on the right fore, which again blocked to the foot.

DIAGNOSIS

X rays of Millie's feet showed she had a slightly broken back conformation. The palmar angle (the angle the pedal bone makes with the floor) is almost flat, whereas it should be 3-8 degrees.



PLAN





Millie is a sensitive mare to change. Hayden and her farrier decided to start with a slight raised heel pad to support Millie's lack of heel and to improve the angle between the pedal bone and the floor. The picture on the left is after the first shoeing and on the right after the second shoeing – you can see the change in her shape already! We are pleased to say Millie seems happy & sound with her new designer shoes and will be closely monitored and re x rayed in the coming months.
